**RE: *County Road 89 at Dogtown
Temporary Road Closure***

Beginning Tuesday morning, May 31st, the DeKalb County Road Department will be temporarily closing a portion of County Road 89, at a point approximately 0.5 miles north of Dogtown Crossroads. The closure is in relation to an unplanned pipe replacement. The closure is expected to last until Thursday afternoon, June 2nd. Local residential traffic will be allowed, but no through traffic will be allowed.

A detour, approximately 2.2 miles in length, will be provided as follows:

South bound on CR-89 from Fort Payne:

Take CR-249 east to CR-248; then CR-248 south to SR-176; then SR-176 west to Dogtown Crossroads

North bound on CR-89 from Dogtown Crossroads:

Take SR-176 east from Dogtown Crossroads to CR-248; then CR-248 north to CR-249; then CR-249 west to CR-89

Please travel with caution and reduce your speed, as the detour County Roads are more narrow and have been recently resurfaced with bituminous surface treatments and have loose gravel.
