Alabama will hold its annual severe weather preparedness sales tax holiday, beginning Friday, February 21, at 12:01 a.m. and ending Sunday, February 23, at midnight. This event gives shoppers the opportunity to purchase certain severe weather preparedness items free of state sales tax. Local sales tax may still apply.
