

3. Closing of the Historic Courthouse

The Cherokee County Commission hereby formally recognizes the closing of the historic Cherokee County Courthouse constructed in 1937.

The Commission expresses its deep appreciation for the generations of judges, public servants, attorneys, and citizens who have passed through its doors and contributed to the administration of justice within its walls.

The historic courthouse shall stand as a lasting symbol of Cherokee County's heritage, service, and commitment to the rule of law.

4. Transition of Operations

All courts, offices, and related judicial functions shall transition to the new courthouse effective April 15, 2026, subject to administrative coordination as necessary to ensure a smooth and orderly transition.
